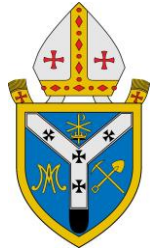

Dear parish leaders,

Following the induction meeting of the new APC last Saturday, we herewith share the 2nd AMOF25 information letter with you. On the **21st of June 2025** the Archdiocese will host its 4th rendition of **AMOF**. The **Archdiocesan Meeting Of Families**, headed by the Youth Department in collaboration with Evangelisation and Marriage & Family Life, has been instituted as the main annual youth month event, “by the youth for the church”. With many opportunities for faith, fellowship and fun, from plenaries, kids’ play activities, family prayer walks, Mass with the Archbishop, food/merchandise/ministry stalls, talent competition and more, we hope to see many of you at AMOF25 at the **Bosco Centre in Walkerville**.

Registration was launched during the diocesan World Youth Day celebration on 23 Nov 2024 and remains open. As stated on the online registration form:

1. Registration cost per person is **R100**. We encourage that you register as a **PARISH/GROUP**. Parishes that register **20 or more** people get a 10% discount.
2. Kids **below age 3** enter **free**.
3. The cost per person will increase to **R130** from **21 MAY 2025**. Discount will still apply for groups of 20 or more.
4. Conference Kits will be handed out upon entrance. Kindly be sure to provide correct information, particularly in terms of numbers attending.
5. **Talent Competition Registration** is [HERE](#).
6. **Camping chairs/blankets** are advisable. In-house seating will only be available during plenary sessions.
7. **Food & merchandise** stalls will be available. Bring cash along. Some stalls may offer card payment facilities.
8. **REGISTRATION CLOSES 31 MAY 2025**.

[REGISTER HERE](#). You will receive an email with an invoice (be sure to provide the correct email address). Once we receive your proof of payment, we request that you make arrangements for your tickets to be collected at the Chancery offices.

PRACTICAL REGISTRATION SUGGESTION: We request that parish youth leaders, with the support of their PPCs, set up an AMOF registration station after each Sunday Mass. Compile a list of those interested in attending (do not include kids below age 3) and have one representative register on behalf of the parish. No names are needed, except for the name and contact details of the main representative, and the number of people registering.


