We thank all those that have made efforts to promote and register for the 4th annual *Archdiocesan Meeting of Families 2025* (AMOF25), themed *Walk in Hope* (cf. Is 40:31). Following a grace period until the 8th of June, registrations have now been closed. A reminder that the doors remain open as walk-in registrations will go ahead as usual. The price remains R130 pp (kids below age 3 free), and extra delegate packs will be available but limited. More information remains available at the [AMOF webpage](#). Parishes and deaneries with the largest registration quantity will be rewarded during the prize-giving segment.

Thank you to those that have made payments and collected tickets. Kindly note that proof of payment must be presented when tickets are collected. Those that have registered online without paying will be regarded as walk-in registrants. Some suggestions for ticket collection on your behalf:

2. If a weekday collection is not possible, arrange for a weekend or after-hours collection with Dillon (072 822 5139)
3. Network with members of neighbouring parishes who may be collecting
4. Ask a friend/family member who works or travels nearby or at the Chancery




Kindly make an effort to collect tickets, as arriving on the day without them will complicate and delay logistics at the gate.

Gates open at **7:30am**. Delegates are reminded to bring camping chairs and/or picnic blankets. Food, beverages and merchandise (incl. theme and AMOF shirts) will be for sale by multiple stalls with a variety of food and other refreshments. Please do bring enough cash as card payments may not be available. A reminder that alcohol is not permitted at the request of the Bosco Centre management.


